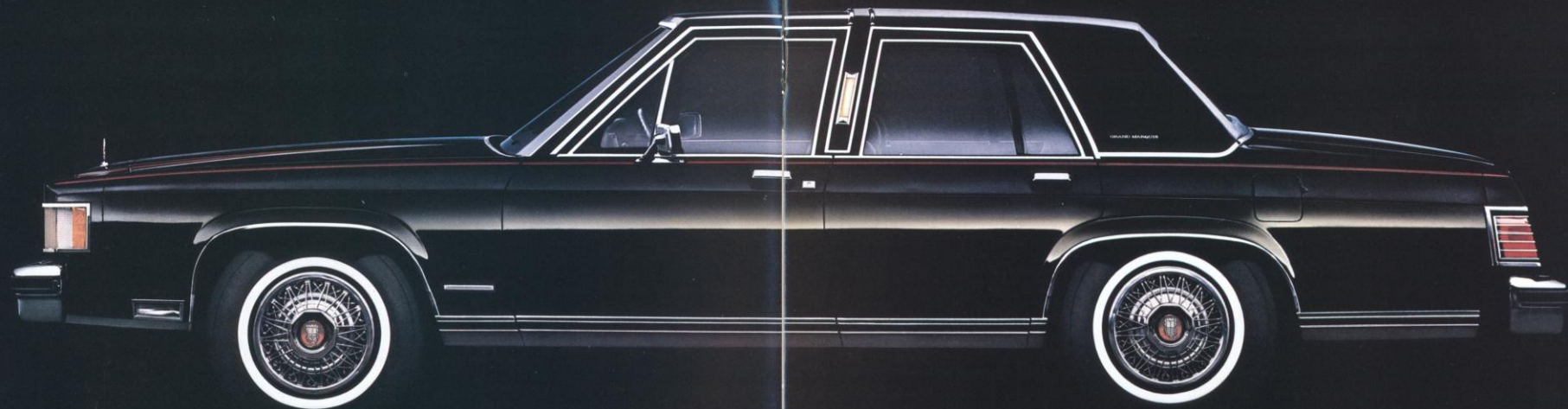

Welcome back an old friend you probably thought you'd never see again. The American car the way it was always meant to be for you. Full-size. Smooth riding. Comfortable.

This is Mercury Grand Marquis for '83. Still a leader among a select few. Refined. Successful. Richer than ever, in fact. Rich enough to be called "Grand Marquis" because it has both the hardware and the software to back its boast of being one very luxurious full-size Mercury.

A carefully engineered suspension system eases the ride. Thoughtfully designed seating comfortably supports the body. Strategically placed acoustical materials quiet the space around you.

But Grand Marquis is more than insulation and isolation from the harsher realities of life on the road.

Everywhere you look, this is a car of quality and substance. As is to be expected, the styling is elegant, the

appointments and materials first-rate, the standard equipment level outstanding.

Steering, brakes and windows are all power. So is the electronically fuel-injected 5.0 liter V-8 which resides under Grand Marquis' classic hoodline. The transmission is, of course, automatic with an overdrive fourth gear for more efficient highway-speed driving.* Steel-belted white sidewall radial tires glide you across the endless miles which lie beyond Grand Marquis' halogen headlamps.

Activate the optional on-board Tripfinder® computer and receive data such as average speed and fuel usage instantly. Turn on the standard four-speaker AM/FM stereo radio. Ease back into the standard cloth-covered Twin Comfort Lounge seats and take the time to reacquaint yourself with the tradition of comfort and elegance which has always marked the Grand Marquis among the leaders in its class, year after year. Then ask yourself: Why should 1983 be any

different? And why should you be driving anything less than Mercury's finest?

A LESSON IN LUXURY

There's more to life than luxury. There's roominess, too...especially if you like to share your luxury with family and friends. Unfortunately, only a few cars these days offer generous helpings of both. Fortunately, one of these cars is the elegant yet affordable Mercury Grand Marquis LS.

One look at Grand Marquis LS' standard interior, shown above, clearly illustrates Mercury's intention of spoiling you from the very beginning. The aptly named Twin Comfort Lounge seats are upholstered in rich cloth and feature dual seatback

recliners, plus dual fold-down center

armrests that allow you to tailor your seating arrangements for two or three in front. Further adjustments are available in the form of six-way power seat options for either the driver's side alone or both driver's and passenger's sides. Further luxury is available in the form of optional leather seating surfaces.

Rear-seat passengers receive special attention as well. There's a fold-down center armrest which again turns comfortable seating for three into luxurious seating for two. There are even pockets located on the front seatbacks for storage of maps, magazines and other materials.

Grand Marquis LS' door panels also get the luxury treatment. They're covered in the same rich cloth as the seats and feature woodtone trimmed full-length armrests with courtesy lights. The lower door panels are covered in cut-pile carpeting, as are the floor and the deep-well 22.4 cubic foot trunk.

By now, it should be rather apparent that Grand Marquis' interior design philosophy goes beyond just seating six to seating them very well indeed. It's a lesson in luxury from the people at Lincoln-Mercury who obviously know what luxury is all about.

CLASS DISTINCTION

Some people would have you believe that luxurious full-size automobiles come just one way these days...with four doors. Lincoln-Mercury knows better.

You don't have to move down to a smaller car to indulge your taste for a more exuberant driving style. You can just move into a 1983 Grand Marquis two-door Sedan instead.

One look at its distinctive rear-quarter window, wrapover roof molding and

coach lamps tells you this is a car designed for the style-conscious driver.

The clues to this car's character continue inside. The standard reclining Twin Comfort Lounge seating shared with Grand Marquis four-door turns into a pair of individual seats when you fold down either or both center armrests. The standard four-spoke steering wheel and brushed aluminum and woodtone trimmed instrument panel—also

standard on the four-door—add to the sporty, personal luxury car flavor.

All the important items that enhance the experience of driving any Grand Marquis add a special excitement to the two-door. An electronically fuel-injected 5.0 liter V-8 and an Automatic Overdrive Transmission start you off on the right road.

To keep you there, you'll find power steering, a power front disc/rear drum

braking system, steel-belted white sidewall radial tires, and a front stabilizer bar. All standard.

There's more to the definition of a luxurious personal car, however. Rest assured that the Grand Marquis two-door has those other attributes in abundance.

The ride is smooth, the interior impressive, the standard four-speaker AM/FM stereo radio very effective indeed. But the options you can add are

as outstanding in their own way as the standards you already have.

For instance, there's a wide range of sound systems for the music lover. A handling suspension, leather-wrapped steering wheel and cornering lamps for the driving enthusiast. An illuminated Entry System and power door locks for the security-minded. A tilt steering wheel, fingertip speed control and illuminated visor vanity mirrors for convenience

seekers. Six-way power seats and leather seating for lovers of luxury.

CLASS ACT

Here's good news for full-size aficionados who prefer a Grand Marquis more basic than an LS. The six-passenger beauty shown above is called simply "Grand Marquis," yet it's still everything the name implies.

There's no lack of bright moldings or trim. Handsome deluxe wheel covers complement the steel-belted white sidewall radial tires that are shared with

the LS. And, of course, the styling is pure Grand Marquis from stem to stern...from the new vertical bar grille design flanked by dual halogen headlamps and topped by the classic hood ornament, to the redesigned taillamps.

This Grand Marquis maintains its standards in mechanical areas as well. Power steering and brakes team up with an electronically fuel-injected 5.0 liter V-8

engine and an Automatic Overdrive Transmission to provide levels of handling and performance long associated with the pleasure of owning and driving a full-size automobile.

A concern for quality and convenience continues inside Grand Marquis. Here too, the seating is of the Twin Comfort Lounge variety, covered in a rich cloth and featuring dual recliners.

The thick carpeting and deluxe seat belts are color-keyed, as are the instrument panel and four-spoke luxury steering wheel. Woodtone accents trim the door panels, steering wheel and lower instrument panel.

The center armrests fold to allow you the option of accommodating either two or three front-seat passengers. The lockable glove box and the ashtray are lit

for easier use, while a luxury sound insulation package allows you to enjoy the standard AM/FM stereo radio even more by helping make things quieter.

To achieve even higher levels of comfort, convenience and class, there's a long list of options just waiting to serve your needs. You'll find everything from air conditioning and an electronic digital clock to a Premium Sound System and vent windows.

The 1983 Mercury Grand Marquis is available in both two-door and four-door Sedans...to give you two basically beautiful ways to travel long distances in the comfort and style you've grown accustomed to.

WORKING CLASSIC

The Lincoln-Mercury people know that there's more than one way to build a first-class people and parcel mover that's as handsome as it is hardworking.

Witness the attention lavished on the Grand Marquis Colony Park and Colony Park LS Wagons. You could think of them as Grand Marquis Sedans with very large and extremely functional glassed-in cargo compartments.

Even with the rear seat up, there's a lot of room for luggage, groceries and the like. 52.5* cubic feet, in fact. Fold the rear seat and cargo capacity is increased to a very commodious 89.3* cubic feet. That's big enough for furniture, building materials or camping gear.

Transporting loads large and small is made all the easier by the standard three-way tailgate and tinted power tailgate window. Smaller precious cargo

can be fitted into special lockable stowage compartments in the quarter trim panel and under the load floor. Bigger valuables are protected by removable cargo compartment carpeting which also keeps the load floor free from unsightly scratches.

While their exteriors are graced by the classic styling and elegant accents long associated with the Grand Marquis Sedans (like the special roof pillar coach

lamps), the Colony Parks add a few special touches of their own. Namely, the standard rosewood-tone bodyside and tailgate accent panels and the optional chrome-plated rooftop luggage rack, which dramatically increases the already impressive carrying capacity.

The Colony Parks' capacity for pleasing passengers is as conspicuous as the Grand Marquis Sedans'. Standard seating for six is highlighted by Twin

Comfort Lounge seats covered in easy-to-clean vinyl or the more luxurious LS cloth shown above. (Removable dual facing rear seats can be ordered for the cargo compartment area to increase passenger capacity to eight.)

The handsome instrument panel also shown above includes easy-to-read instrumentation and easy-to-reach controls which keep the driver in close touch with all of the many standard

features...the 5.0 liter electronically fuel-injected V-8 engine, Automatic Overdrive Transmission, power steering, power brakes, power windows, analog quartz clock, AM/FM stereo radio and more.

Whatever it is you're carrying, Mercury has a classic way to carry it...in the Colony Park Wagon of your choice.

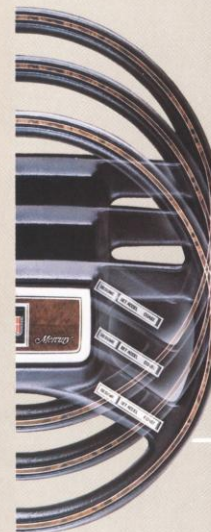

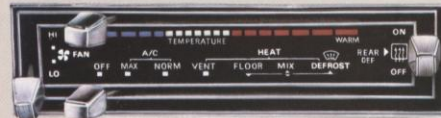

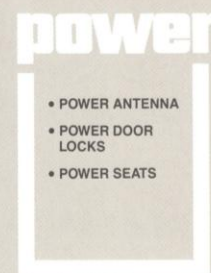

Your new Mercury Grand Marquis comes equipped with factory-engineered and approved parts including a dependable Motorcraft battery, shock absorbers, spark plugs, long life oil filters, and motor oil. For continued top performance, be sure to specify genuine Motorcraft parts whenever replacement is necessary.



EXTENDED SERVICE PLAN

Ford Motor Company's optional Extended Service Plan covers certain components on new Lincoln-Mercury cars for longer than the vehicle's basic warranty. The cost is so moderate for the protection you get that it could pay for itself the first time you need it. Ask your Lincoln-Mercury Dealer for complete details of the Plan, which is available on cars sold and normally operated in the 50 United States and Canada.

MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

The Ford Motor Company wants to reduce both the frequency and cost of scheduled maintenance on its cars to an absolute minimum. And compared to just a few years ago, we're making strides in that direction. For example, in 1973, an engine oil change was called for each 4,000 miles. For 1983, Grand Marquis oil changes are recommended at 7,500-mile intervals. Other recommended intervals are now 30,000 miles between spark plug changes; 30,000 miles between air filter replacements; 52,500 miles or three years between engine coolant replacements. We're proud of these improvements, and we're working constantly to make them even better.

FORD-PAID REPAIR PROGRAMS AFTER THE WARRANTY PERIOD

Sometimes Ford Motor Company offers adjustment programs to pay all or part of the cost of certain repairs. These programs are intended to assist owners and are in addition to the warranty or to required recalls. Ask Ford Motor Company or your Lincoln-Mercury Dealer about such programs relating to your Ford or Lincoln-Mercury vehicle.

To get copies of any adjustment program for your vehicle or the vehicle of interest to you:

We'll need your name and address; year, make, model, and vehicle ID no., as well as engine size; and whether you have a manual or automatic transmission.

TECHNICAL SERVICE BULLETINS

All vehicles need repairs during their lifetime. Sometimes Ford issues Technical Service Bulletins (TSBs) and easy-to-read explanations describing unusual engine or transmission conditions which may lead to costly repairs, the recommended repairs, and new repair procedures. Often a repair now can prevent a more serious repair later. Ask Ford Motor Company or your Lincoln-Mercury Dealer for any such TSBs and explanations relating to your Ford or Lincoln-Mercury vehicle.

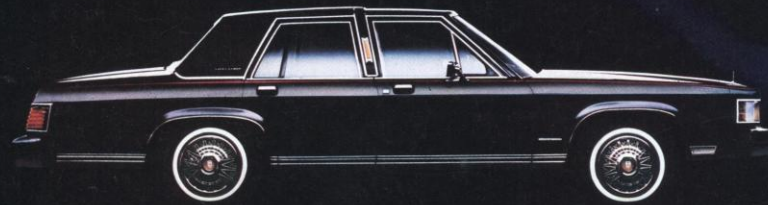
